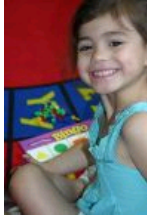


Bingo nights are sociable, fun and easy to run. Anyone can participate in charitable bingo, even children.



